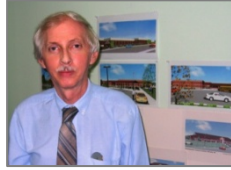


MA's architectural unit is headed by Chief Architect, John Gross, R.A., LEED AP. This year, two successful projects were completed and the doors were opened to the users.

Teasley Elementary School - Design for major modifications on Teasley Elementary School began in late 2013. The school is located in Smyrna. The \$14 million project included a three story, 50,000 square foot addition and major renovation of existing classrooms, cafeteria and kitchen.



John served as Project Manager and Chief Architect. He was assisted for landscape architecture by Chris Kingsbury, ASLA, RLA.



McCollum Field in Cobb County transformed into the **Cobb International Airport** in June - 2015 with the ribbon-cutting for Customs Inspection Facility. John Gross served as Project Manager and Chief Architect. He was assisted for civil/site work by Eric Brown, PE and Moreland Altobelli also provided full geotechnical services on the project.



The Facility is manned by the U.S. Customs and Border Protection and creates a port-of-entry for international flights. The facility was designed to comply with stringent CBP standards including security and operational features and included Waiting, Processing, Holding and Administrative areas. Backup power systems were included.
